## **JUNIOR CERTIFICATE MOCK EXAMINATION RULES**

1. Students are assigned to a seat for the duration of the exams.
2. All students must be seated at 8.45 a.m. and 1.15p.m., regardless of the start time of the examination. The exception is where an afternoon examination commences at an earlier time as indicated in the timetable.
3. Students may study until the exam begins. During exams all books are put in school bag and it is placed neatly under your chair.
4. Students must be in school all day during the exams. If they have no exam you must study for the next one **in the exam centre** where supervision is provided.
5. Full uniform must be worn at all times.
6. Exam answer books will be supplied by the supervising teacher. Students must fill in name and level on answer book.
7. Mobile phones are not allowed in exam centres. You are advised to leave your phone at home if possible, otherwise it must be stored securely in your locker.
8. Eating is not permitted in the centres. Students may only have a bottle of water in the exam centre.
9. Cheating in an examination will be considered to be a serious breach of our Code of Behaviour.
