## **LEAVING CERTIFICATE STUDENTS EXAMINATION RULES**

1. Full Uniform must be worn at all times.
2. All students must be seated at 8.45a.m. and 1.15p.m. for exams regardless of the time at which the examination starts (except where an afternoon examination starts at an earlier time, in which case you must be seated **at least** 5 minutes before the exam commences).
3. Exam answer booklets will be supplied by supervising teacher. Students must fill in names and level on answer booklet.
4. Mobile phones are not allowed in exam centres. Please leave your phone at home if possible, otherwise ensure it is securely stored in your locker.
5. Students must remain seated in an exam until the supervising teacher has given permission to leave.
6. Students may study at home if not scheduled for an exam. Each student must take note of the time of her exam.
7. Students may only have a bottle of water in the exam centre.
8. Cheating in an examination will be considered to be a serious breach of our Code of Behaviour.
